### Site Presentation



We'd like to remind all trades about some key site standards that are part of your UBS agreement.

#### **Dress Code:**

All trades must wear long-sleeve tops and long pants on every job. This supports UBS's commitment to SunSmart practices and is a requirement of our ISO certification, which helps us secure work from our major clients. High-visibility clothing and appropriate PPE are also mandatory.

#### **Site Presentation:**

Please keep work areas clean and tidy. Any damage or mess left behind may result in rectification costs being passed back to the trade.

#### **Professional Conduct:**

All communication on-site must be respectful and professional—no swearing, aggression, or inappropriate behaviour. UBS reserves the right to remove individuals who do not meet this standard.

These expectations are part of the signed trade contract. Thank you for helping us maintain the high standards that keep work flowing for everyone.

# Sending us reports/invoices



We've recently received a few reports of trades having trouble uploading invoices, reports, and other documents. We know how important it is that payments go through seamlessly, so here are some of the most common problems we see and how to fix them.

Please ensure you are following the correct process when sending documents to docs@uniquebuilding.com.au:

- Include the correct keyword (Invoice, Report, SWMS) and UBS 5-digit job number in the subject line.
- Send documents in PDF format (for invoices, reports, SWMS, quotes, and plans).
- Photos must be JPG, JPEG, or PNG between 50kb and 300kb. An image resizer can be used for this.
- Attach documents directly; do not send download links.
- Review and correct any errors if you receive a partial failure or failure notice.

Common upload issues:

- Incorrect or missing subject line
- Wrong file size or type
- Sender email not registered
- Documents embedded instead of attached

If you are using Xero, MYOB, QuickBooks or a similar platform, ensure the setup sends PDFs correctly and that the subject line is **manually updated with the information we need.** 

Following these guidelines helps avoid delays.

#### **Project: Flood Damage Repairs**

Following severe flood damage at a residential property, Unique Building Services was engaged to complete a comprehensive make safe and restoration project.

The restoration included:

- Replacement of flood-affected wall plaster, skirting, doors, and architraves across multiple rooms
- Full repainting to match existing finishes
